COMPETITION FORMAT/RULES

The competition will be carried out according to the UIPM Rules and Equipment Regulations.

- **Fencing:** 9 pistes indoor.
- **Obstacle:** Outdoors - straight line - grass surface.
- **Swimming:** 25m Indoor pool - 5 lanes.
- **Laser Run:** 36+2 shooting range with Pentashot hit&miss.
- **Running Course:** Grass surface.

COMPETITION VENUE

Fencing, Obstacle, Swimming and Laser Run will be held in LSC sport complex University UCJC.

ACCOMMODATION

The participants will be accommodated at the UCJC University residence and the Student Experience Madrid Pozuelo. The Technical Meeting and the LOC Office will be at the competition venue.

Rooms are reserved for the first time, registering first, from residences:

- UCJC Villafranca Campus, (at the venue).
- Student Experience Madrid Pozuelo, (15 minutes from the venue).

Please note that if you are interested in staying at a particular residence, we recommend that you register for the event as soon as possible to increase your chances of getting a room in a preferred location.

WARNING

Should a minor athlete be in need to share the hotel accommodation with another adult athlete (18+) or with an accompanying adult (e.g., Coach) it is required for such arrangement to be supported by the prior written consent of the parents/legal guardian of each of the minors. Providing the requested written consent is a must for checking in the competition accommodation. In addition, minor athletes sharing rooms must be of the same gender.

TRANSPORT

LOC guarantees transport from/to the national airport of Adolfo Suarez Madrid-Barajas Airport in Madrid to all official accommodations on arrival and departure days. The maximum waiting time for delegations at the airport is 1 hour.

Transportation from the Official Hotels to the Technical Meeting and the venues for delegations will be arranged according to the competition program.

FINANTIAL CONDITIONS

For delegations (athletes, coaches, officials, supporters) reserving the conditions accommodation package, the prices are as follows:

- This price includes full board accommodation, local transportation (from the competition hotel, including airport transfers).
- Delegations wishing to arrange their own accommodation must pay an accreditation fee per participant (athlete, coach or official) to the LOC. The amount of the Accreditation fee is set at EUR 50 per day per person, a minimum payment of 3 days. For this, we will provide lunch for the competition days and allow access to official transportation between the competition local accommodation and competition sites.
- The check-out hour is 11.00 am. If the delegates will stay more time must pay additionally for accommodation and/or meals (½ day). Please inform the LOC about the extension of the extra day and extra meal.
- In the case of a bank transfer, the head of the delegation must have a confirmation of the transfer with him.

ATTENTION! Only the EURO currency is accepted. All extra costs for bank transfers must be paid by the national federations. Otherwise, the amount will be invoiced afterward.

Paying cash upon arrival is only accepted if you have written approval from the LOC to do so and all financial conditions (costs) will be calculated on the prices mentioned above.

As a reminder, if on arrival for the competition, the team has fewer athletes and/or officials than listed in the registration system and without informing the LOC at least 7 days prior to their arrival, the NF will pay a fine to the Organizing Nation/LOC of 200 Euros for each person not attending.

At the same time as submitting the Final Entries all NFs must send to the LOC by electronic bank transfer or other means, 30% of the total amount of their accommodation invoice, otherwise their reservation will not be guaranteed.

DEADLINES

Delegations are kindly reminded that the UIPM Online registration system is obligatory. The online system will be open from 1 June 2026. All information must be submitted, including flight information, pistol serial numbers and accommodation bookings by 20 July 2026. Any changes after this must be sent by email to the organizer wchmadrid26@pentatlon.info.

Following the closure of the registration system on 20 July 2026, an NF must enter the competition with at least one pentathlete/team per confirmed gender. Any failure to take part having sent their final entries will pay a fine of 600€ to the UIPM.

Deadlines are as follows

If complete information about your delegation or payment confirmation is not received prior to the closure of the registration system, your delegation will be considered as non-participating.

ATHLETES LICENSES

Athletes are only allowed to participate in UIPM sanctioned events if they are in possession of a valid Athletes License. Registration is not possible without a License Number. If an athlete does not have a license, they will not be allowed to take part in the competition. You are reminded of Rule 1.12.1 i).

INSURANCE

According to UIPM Rules, all members of attending delegations should insure themselves in case of accidental injury and illness.

The organizer will not accept any financial liability or loss, injury or illness that occurred to any participant and or member of the delegation.

VISA & VACCINATION

Visiting NFs should confirm visa and vaccination requirements for entry into SPAIN prior travelling to the event. The LOC cannot accept responsibility for arranging visas but can provide specific letters of invitation if needed.

GENERAL INFORMATION

All participants (athletes, coaches, doctors and other team members) are kindly requested to wear their official national uniform at the competition. Please also bring a track/record of your anthem and a national flag (120x80 cm).

Expected weather conditions:

The average daytime high temperature in Madrid at the end of August is around 32°C (89.6°F). The average minimum temperature drops to approximately 19°C (66.2°F), usually during the night. Rainfall during this period is generally low, with an average of around 10–15 mm, and rainy days are infrequent. Overall, the weather is typically hot and dry, with plenty of sunshine.
